CHILDREN'S HOMES MINISTRY

Purpose: Provide food, clothing, shelter, medical & trauma care, and spiritual guidance for children within the nurturing Christian environments of five homes

Where: The metropolitan area of Yangon which is Myanmar's most populous city of an estimated six million people, and its commercial center

By Whom: Each home is under the direction of experienced Christian men and women most of whom are seminary graduates

For: Newborn children to teenagers who have been separated from their families because of abuse, death, divorce, education, poverty, or war

How Many: Approximately 150 children. The number periodically changes because of the impact of the ongoing civil war.

Budget: [Total \$25,290 for all five homes annually; \$168 per child annually or \$14 per child monthly]

- food supplies- \$21,840
- school supplies- \$1,500
- home directors training- \$1,200
- medical emergencies- \$750
