



## LOVE FOR MYANMAR

### DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING MINISTRY

Purpose: To ensure the leaders of our house churches and key others receive regular, scriptural-based, Christ-centered training from Christians experienced with the Myanmar culture. Among the goals are to help our house church leaders and key others with: a) their ongoing, personal spiritual development, b) their understanding of being accountable to Jesus Christ for sharing the gospel, and c) realizing the importance of conducting themselves with good will towards all others, regardless of religious backgrounds, as examples of genuine Christianity's unconditional love.

Where: Yangon & Mawlamyine, Myanmar

When: quarterly, beginning January 2021

By whom: Gilbert David, LFM National Director & Ordained Minister

For: leaders of house churches, fellowship coordinators, children's homes directors

How many: 50 persons per event

Resource: "Follow Jesus" curriculum developed by Dan Lancaster, PhD and former IMB missionary in Myanmar, and Gilbert David. This material uses pictures, stories, and easy-to-remember lessons to train semi-literate believers how to follow Jesus.

Budget per 3-day event:[\$77 per participant per three-day event]

Participants food, lodging, transportation- \$2,500

Participants stipends for lost wages- \$750

Training facility, handout materials, A/V-\$600

Total per event= \$3,850

Grand total four events= \$15,400

It is important to note that *in between* these quarterly events, our house church leaders will be counseled through Zoom to follow up with them about their experiences *with applying* what they learned in the training sessions.
