NEIGHBORHOOD LEARNING CENTERS MINISTRY

Purpose: To supplement children's education in the government schools with tutoring sessions which also include exposure to Christian values and beliefs

Where: The metropolitan area of Yangon which is Myanmar's most populous city of an estimated six million people, and its commercial center

By whom: Our one neighborhood learning center is managed by a strong Christian married couple who each have a seminary degree

For: Primarily for school-aged Buddhist children; however, some Christian children are participating in the two hour sessions M-F evenings

How many: Presently, there is one learning center with 15 children. Our goal is to start another learning center in a poor Buddhist neighborhood in Yangon.

Budget: [Total \$5,280 per learning center annually; \$352 per child annually or \$29 per child monthly]

- Teacher Instruction Fee- \$1,200
- Teaching Supplies- \$600
- Facility Rent, Utilities, Furnishings- \$3,000
- Snacks- \$480
