

LOVE FOR MYANMAR CHILDREN'S HOMES MINISTRY

<u>Purpose</u>: Provide food, clothing, shelter, medical & trauma care, and spiritual guidance for children within

the nurturing Christian environments of five homes

<u>Where</u>: The metropolitan area of Yangon which is Myanmar's most populous city of an estimated six million people, and its commercial center

By whom: Each home is under the direction of experienced Christian men and women most of whom are seminary graduates

<u>For</u>: Newborn children to teenagers who have been separated from their families because of abuse, death, divorce, education, poverty, or war

<u>How many</u>: Approximately 130 children. The number periodically changes because of the impact of the ongoing civil war.

Budget: [Total \$32,760 for all five homes annually; \$252 per child annually or \$21 per child monthly]

- food supplies- \$24,160
- school supplies- \$1,000
- outreach events- \$1,000
- medical emergencies- \$2,000
- building repair expenses- \$1,000
- staff coordination- \$3,600
