COUP-RELATED ATROCITIES BY MYANMAR MILITARY JUNTA

• Randomly search homes and businesses without warrants, then loot, destroy property

- Establish military posts in schools and hospitals as shields against attacks on their forces
- Arrest doctors and nurses who treat protesters against the junta and revoke their professional licenses, passports
- Stop ambulances transporting injured protesters dragging them out and leaving them in the street
- Kidnap male youth and use them as porters and human shields for military operations
- Take and torture family members of protesters as hostages when protester has evaded capture
- Destroyed or damaged churches throughout the country
- Cut off essential public services such as water and electricity from cities unsupportive of the junta as well as access to the internet
- Establish checkpoints on major roadways and confiscate cargo, cash, and even food intended for local markets
- Raid food distribution stations set up to help struggling families and use for soldiers and their families; purposefully destroyed farms to starve people
- Monitor, seize, close bank accounts to stop the flow of international financial assistance for the civil disobedience movement
- Seized Covid-19 vaccine supplies intended for the public and used them solely for military personnel
- Conduct bombings with jet fighter aircraft on innocent, rural villagers displacing over three million now living in jungles and caves
- Place landmines around bombed villages to kill even more who return to their homes
- Revoked the licenses of newspapers, arrested and tortured journalists, severed social media connections
- Arrested 28,550 civilian protesters sentencing 168 to death so far including university students, and many others to 20 years imprisonment with hard labor
- Aung San Suu Kyi and key members of her democratically-elected parliament have been tried in courts located within the prisons and sentenced to decades of imprisonment
