Gospel sharing through house church network: \$2,758 per house church to provide regular scriptural-based training to house church leaders as well as supplies for periodic outreach to area villagers

<u>Good News Outreach Christmas Events</u>: Forty one (41), one-day Christmas events throughout Myanmar at \$2.73 per participant

<u>Good News Outreach Bible Camp Events</u>: Two (2), one-day Bible Camps for school-aged children at \$11 per child

<u>Trauma Healing for Youth Program</u>: Address the alcohol & drug challenges faced by the youth from leprosy villages through a Scripture-based curriculum developed by the American Bible Society at \$87 per youth

<u>Children's Homes Ministry</u>: Meet the humanitarian needs of abandoned children at \$252 per child annually or \$21 per child monthly

<u>Village Education Program</u>: Provide education classes where schools have been closed due to junta hostilities as well as tutoring sessions for children whose schools are open to help them with their lessons while exposing them to Christian values and beliefs at \$9.38 per child monthly

<u>Food Distribution Program (BAG)</u>: One bag of food supplies cost \$42, and typically consists of rice, cooking oil, spices, and a vegetable. Medicines, sleeping mats, mosquito nets, blankets, and other survival items are included as resources allow.
