## **WHY MYANMAR**

Myanmar faces immense challenges and suffering due to a military coup, economic collapse, and ongoing conflict. Over 31.5 million people live below the international poverty line of \$2.15 per day. The healthcare system ranks among the worst globally, and the education system is severely underfunded, with 75% of children dropping out before 5th grade.

Religious freedoms are heavily restricted, and the country is plagued by violence, corruption, and human rights abuses. Despite these hardships, the resilience and hope of the Myanmar people shine through. Your support offers them a chance at a better future.

# **OUR PROGRAMS**

Our mission is to encourage, equip, and empower the people of Myanmar through various programs that address their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs. Here are the key areas of our work:

#### Blessed & Giving (BAG) Program

The combination of the pandemic and military coup in Myanmar has created an economic crisis, with over 31.5 million people in need of humanitarian aid. Our BAG Program provides essential food supplies, medicines, sleeping mats, mosquito nets, blankets, and other survival items to those affected by the crisis.

Cost

\$42 per bag (supports a family of four for a month)

#### **Children's Homes Ministry**

We meet the humanitarian and spiritual needs of abandoned children by providing a safe and nurturing environment. This includes food, clothing, shelter, education, and Christ-centered guidance through seminary-trained directors.

Cost \$252/child annually or \$21/child monthly

### **Gospel Sharing through House Church Network**

We provide regular scriptural-based training to house church leaders and supplies for outreach to area villagers.

\$2,758/house church annually

### **Leprosy Hospital & Villages**

Our ministry supports leprosy-affected patients and their families by providing humanitarian, spiritual, and educational support through Christian-based Chaplain services. We aim to improve their quality of life and integrate them into the community.

\$500 per month

### **Trauma Healing**

We address the alcohol and drug challenges plaguing the youth facing a hopeless future as well as the traumatic effects of the coup-related violence on Myanmar families.

Cost

\$87 per youth

### **Education Program**

Supplements children's education with tutoring sessions and basic classes that include exposure to Christian values and beliefs. Organized by our Fellowship Coordinators with parental input and employing qualified teachers, this program is customized to the local needs of the rural village or poor urban neighborhoods.

\$4,500/location annually | \$112.50/child annually
